### 1.0 RULES

1.1 The regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing

1.2 The Yachting New Zealand Safety Regulations Part 1 shall apply

### 2.0 ADVERTISING

2.1 The Organizing Authority may require all participating boats to display the event sponsor's advertising

### 3.0 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY FEE

3.1 J14s and Finns

3.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the entry sheet in the clubhouse at registration, accompanied by the entry fee.

The entry fee of \$50.00 may be paid by internet banking to Waiuku Yacht Club BNZ Waiuku account number 02 0476 0017633 00 prior to 1600 on 8<sup>th</sup> October to be eligible for the regatta.

### 4.0 RACING SCHEDULE

Saturday 8th Oct. 0730 Gates open, 0800 Registration

Saturday 8th Oct. 0845 Briefing

Saturday 8th Oct. 0915 Start first race

Three races to be sailed back-to-back, weather conditions permitting

Sunday 9th Oct. 1000 Start first race

Three races to be sailed back-to-back, weather conditions permitting

Sunday 9th Oct. Prize giving ASAP after racing

## 5.0 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1 The Sailing Instructions will be given verbally at the briefing.

## 6.0 RACING AREA

6.1 The racing area is Waiuku basin

## 7.0 THE COURSE

7.1 The courses will be windward – leeward.

7.2 A windward offset mark to start the downwind leg may be used.

7.3 A leeward gate to end the downwind leg may be used.

## 8.0 SCORING

8.1 The scoring system will be the low points system

8.2 One race will be required to be completed to constitute a series

8.3 When fewer than 5 races have been completed a boat's series score will be the total of race scores.

8.4 When 5 or more races have been completed a boat's series score will be the total of race scores excluding the worst score

## 9.0 PRIZES

9.1 Prizes will be awarded as follows: 1st 2nd 3<sup>rd</sup> for each class, depending on entries and at the discretion of the race committee.

## 10.0 PRIVACY WAIVER

10.1 In participating in the regatta, a competitor grants the organizing authority and the sponsors the right in perpetuity, to make, use and show, from time to time and at their discretion any motion picture, still picture and live taped or film television and other reproductions of him/her during the period of the event

## 11.0 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

11.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury, or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta
